



SPECIFICATIONS TO RECEIVE RWDCA APPROVED SHOW STATUS

Classes may be eliminated but not added. However, individual classes offered must follow what is listed below. A letter from the show management requesting approved status and stating they will adhere to these rules is required to be an approved show for the All-American contest.

1. There is a separate show using RWDCA classes and for Red & Whites only.
2. Animals must be RWDCA registered prior to the show.
3. Owner must be a member of RWDCA.
4. Animals must be true red; no brindles or black-reds.
5. Following the show, show management must provide RWDCA with a report that lists all placings, champions, etc.
6. RWDCA will assist show management with determining registry status and member status if provided with a list of entries in a timely manner prior to the show.
7. After RWDCA receives the show report, individual class placings and champion information is entered into the animal's permanent record.

1. Spring Heifer Calf, born March 1, 2011 through May 31, 2011
2. Winter Heifer Calf, born December 1, 2010 through February 29, 2011
3. Fall Heifer Calf, born September 1, 2010 through November 30, 2010
4. Summer Yearling Heifer, born June 1, 2010 through August 31, 2010
5. Spring Yearling Heifer, born March 1, 2010 through May 31, 2010
6. Winter Yearling Heifer, born December 1, 2009 through February 28, 2010
7. Fall Yearling Heifer, born September 1, 2009 through November 30, 2009
Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female
8. Junior Best Three Females, all bred with at least one owned by exhibitor
9. Dry Cow (must have freshened)
10. Fall Yearling in Milk, born September 1, 2009 through November 30, 2009
11. Junior 2 Year Old Cow, (must have freshened) born March 1, 2009 through August 31, 2009
12. Senior 2 Year Old Cow, (must have freshened) born September 1, 2008 through February 28, 2009
13. Junior 3 Year Old Cow, born March 1, 2008 through August 31, 2008
14. Senior 3 Year Old Cow, born September 1, 2007 through February 28, 2008
Intermediate Champion and Reserve Intermediate Female
15. 4 Year Old Cow, born September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2007
16. 5 Year Old Cow, born September 1, 2005 through August 31, 2006
17. Aged Cow 6 Years and Over, born before September 1, 2005
18. 125,000 lbs. Milk, Lifetime (proof of production must accompany cow)
Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female
Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female from each of the female championship classes
Best Udder of Show, best udder winner from each of the milking classes
Best Bred & Owned of Show
19. Senior Best Three Females, all bred with at least one owned by exhibitor
20. Produce of Dam, produce of one cow to consist of two animals, any age, either sex, need not be owned by one exhibitor. Dam must be named.
21. Dam/Daughter, need not be owned by one exhibitor
Premier Exhibitor, based on six placings
Premier Breeder, based on six placings
Premier Sire, based on six placings

Junior Show classes consist of all female classes except Best Udder of Show.

There will be no junior show classes for group classes.
